RESOLUTION No. FG BAC-027-2022

**RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE HoPE FOR DIRECT CONTRACTING
ON THE PROCUREMENT OF ONE (1) LOT OF REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF
IT EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR THE FIREARMS IDENTIFICATION
SYSTEM (FIS)**

WHEREAS, the Firearms Identification System (FIS) is a sophisticated forensic equipment used by the PNP Forensic Group (FG) to capture unique marks left by firearms on fired bullets and cartridge and it is essential in the comparative analysis of all firearm evidence;

WHEREAS, the use of the FIS was institutionalized under Sections 15 and 34 of R.A. 10591 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation (An Act Providing for a Comprehensive Law on Firearms and Ammunition and Providing Penalties for Violations thereof) which provides that the "PNP shall place firearm's information, including its individual or peculiar identifying characteristics into the database of integrated firearms identification system of the PNP Crime Laboratory for future use and identification of a particular firearm";

WHEREAS, the PNP FG as an ISO 9001:2015 forensic institution is committed in providing quality forensic services to the public, and the criminal justice system, and ensures to maintain integrity of examination, timeliness of examination results and the documentation to support analytical data;

WHEREAS, the PNP FG guarantees that all its forensic equipment including the FIS are safeguarded from deterioration to constantly produce accurate results;

WHEREAS, the PNP-FG has allocated Fifty-Seven Million Pesos Only (Php57,000,000.00) for the procurement for one (1) lot of Repair and Maintenance of IT Equipment and Software for Firearm Identification System Maintenance (FIS) from GAA FY 2022;

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **1st OPENING OF BIDS** on June 22, 2022. However, no bids were received and declared as a "**Failure of Bidding**";

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **2nd OPENING OF BIDS** on July 19, 2022. However, no bids were received and declared as a "**Failure of Bidding**";

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **3rd OPENING OF BIDS** on August 22, 2022. However, no bids were received and declared as a “**Failure of Bidding**”;

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **4th OPENING OF BIDS** on September 26, 2022. However, no bids were received and declared as a “**Failure of Bidding**”;

WHEREAS, the failure of bidding is attributed to its proprietary nature wherein the repair and maintenance and its critical components can only be obtained from the existing service provider of FIS;

WHEREAS, the manufacturer of the FIS of the PNP does not have sub-dealers in the country and worldwide that sells and distribute its products and services, and no suitable substitute can be obtained to cover its repair and maintenance;

NOW THEREFORE, the PNP FG BAC **RESOLVE TO RECOMMEND**, as it **HEREBY RECOMMEND** to change the method of procurement from Competitive Bidding to “Direct Contracting” as an alternative method for the procurement of **ONE (1) LOT REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF IT EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR FIREARM IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (FIS)**.
