RESOLUTION No. FG-BAC 33-2022

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE 2nd PUBLIC BIDDING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF ONE (1) LOT ICT EQUIPMENT FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF IT EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR FIREARMS IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM (FIS) AS A “FAILURE OF BIDDING” AND RECOMMENDING TO THE HEAD OF THE PROCURING ENTITY (HoPE) FOR THE CHANGE OF MODE OF PROCUREMENT TO DIRECT CONTRACTING OF THE SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, the PNP-FG has allocated Two Hundred Twenty-Seven Million Pesos Only (PhP227,000,000.00) for the procurement of one (1) lot ICT Equipment for the Enhancement of IT Equipment and Software for Firearm Identification System (FIS) from GAA FY 2022;

WHEREAS, the invitation to apply for eligibility and to bid was posted on November 15, 2022 at PhilGEPS and PNP FG website (<https://fg.pnp.gov.ph/>) and conspicuous places at the premises of the Philippine National Police Headquarters;

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **PRE-PROCUREMENT CONFERENCE** on November 8, 2022, respectively, **PRE-BID CONFERENCE** on November 22, 2022 and **SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF BIDS** on December 5, 2022;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, no prospective bidder signified their intent to bid for the project through purchasing of bid documents and subsequently submitted the corresponding mandatory requirements comprising the Eligibility, Technical and Financial components during the Deadline for Submission and Opening of Bids, thus resulted in the “Failure of Bidding”;

WHEREAS, the PNP FG Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), in compliance with the Republic Act 9184 and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulation, conducted the **1ST OPENING OF BIDS** on November 7, 2022. However, no bids were received and declared as a “**Failure of Bidding**”;

WHEREAS, the ICT equipment (FIS) to be procured must have seamless interconnectivity, compatibility, and security to the existing FIS of the PNPFPG for continuity of its operations and enhance the effectivity and efficiency in the analysis and correlation of firearms evidence;

NOW THEREFORE, the PNP FG BAC **RESOLVE TO RECOMMEND**, as it **HEREBY RECOMMEND** declaring the 2nd Public Bidding held on December 5, 2022 for the procurement of **ONE (1) LOT ICT EQUIPMENT FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF IT EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE FOR FIREARMS IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM**

(FIS) as a “Failure of Bidding” pursuant to Sec 35.1a, IRR of RA 9184, and recommending to HoPE to resort to “Direct Contracting” pursuant to Sec 50 of RA 9184, as an alternative method of procurement for the said project.


